- 🍇 Our *Chardonnay* is a rich full bodied wine that offers pear and apple notes as well as a hint of oak. It will accommodate most palates and is a perfect match for soft cheeses, chicken, fish, creamy pasta dishes and just about anything.
- 🍇 Our lovely *Traminette* is an aromatic wine with floral and tropical fruit notes. The off dry style makes this a amazing wine to have as an aperitif or served with spicy dishes, fish or seafood. The grapes with which this wine was made, were grown in Patrick Henry's Charlotte County at Pinehaven Vineyard & Farm.
- 🍇 The Red Hill *Reserve* is an amazing Cabernet Franc which has been aged for two years in French oak. This wine is a heavier style red with a balance of flavors that integrate to create a full bodied wine. A great wine to serve with hard cheeses, beef, lamb or veal.
- 🍇 *Revolution* is made from the French-American hybrid Chambourcin grape. This wine has abundant dark red fruit aromas with a deeply concentrated, but soft palate structure. A wonderful match for beef, chicken or pasta. *Revolution* makes a nice mulled wine or sangria.

Situated in Charlotte County Virginia, Red Hill is Patrick Henry's last home and burial place. We invite you to visit this 525 acre historic site and stroll along the quiet paths of Red Hill; gaze over Henry's fields and forests virtually unchanged since the 18th century and experience what Henry referred to as "the garden spot of Virginia" overlooking the Staunton River.
